

Sound Healing with the Voice Practitioner Training Course Costs

Practitioner Training Five Weekends Cost

The overall cost of the course is –

£1000 or £900 if paid in full in advance
£1250 or £1,100 if paid in full in London
€1250 or €1,100 if paid in full in Ireland

The cost for each weekend workshop is £200 in the UK / £250 in London / €250 in Ireland. Payment for each workshop should be made in full at least two weeks before the date of the workshop. If payment is made in full in advance for the whole course it is non refundable but can be transferred to a future course with that tutor.

The course cost includes the Course Book ‘Sound Healing Practice’.

Additional Costs

At Part Two - You will need Insurance, Student Membership and the Biosonic C&G Tuning Forks.

Student Membership - £30 (covers you for two years)

Insurance for UK Student Members - £35.50 per annum

Biosonic C&G Tuning Forks - £53.00 plus £3.50 postage

At Part Three - You will need the College Course CD and the Seven Healing Drones CD – they are £10.00 each or £6 each to download from the College website.

After Part Four - Marking Your Final Essay - £25.00 charge

First Aid Course - The First Aid Plus Online Course covers you for 3 years and costs £35. Other First Aid Courses may be more expensive.

Additional Sound Healing Workshops

As well as completing the core curriculum students will need to complete one or two additional Sound Healing Workshops. These workshops can be taken before or during attending the core curriculum. Students can choose from one of these options:

Two one day workshops (minimum 6 hours per day)

One weekend workshop (minimum 12 hours)

The College of Sound Healing Conference

The cost will vary depending on which workshops you choose to attend. A one day workshop will cost between £40 – £80. A two day workshop will cost around £170 – £180
